We have no paid employees only 10-20 Volunteers. All volunteers give many hours of their own time to raise funds. We have an Annual Ball, a Golf Tournament, Beetle Drives, Kart Racing events, Car Boot Sales & Coffee Mornings and take every opportunity to promote our cause as we are able.

Most of us know someone who has Cancer. Many get cured, some are more difficult to treat.

We at The Stan Bowley Trust, support the stage 4 patients that volunteer have clinical trials of CyberKnife radiotherapy treatment, at The Queen Elizabeth Hospital Oncology Centre in Birmingham.

The CyberKnife machine is only one of four in the UK. Costing £3.5 million each, all raised by private donations.

The CyberKnife machine can pin point Cancers in any part of the body, including the brain, by delivering high doses of radiation with sub millimetre accuracy, basically giving hope where there was previously none. Only brain tumours are treated on the NHS, all others have to be privately funded.

That is where The Stan Bowley Trust come in. Started in September, 2011, we maintain the private accommodation & the consumables not provided by the Statutory Authorities for these patients, not just from the Dunchurch Parish Council area, but also from the Greater Midlands area, when they volunteer to have clinical trials at the QEH CyberKnife Treatment Centre when it is not available on the NHS.
